



SCHOLARSHIPS for FReedom to Explore Sexual Health (FRESH) Course: Aboriginal Focus

SHINE SA is offering scholarships for participation in our courses and professional development to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Focused Workers.

Priority for these scholarships will be given to professionals who identify as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander, work with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island people or work in an Aboriginal organisation and who have a strong interest in sexual and reproductive health.

SHINE SA will cover the full cost of the applicant's course of choice (eligible course below). Applicants attending a course that exceeds 1 day in duration can apply for contribution to expenses incurred to attend the course.

Applicants must provide a statement outlining the support required and why, including estimated costs.

FRESH Course: Aboriginal Focus

This 2-day course is for workers who wish to improve their sexual and reproductive health knowledge and support Aboriginal people and communities to improve sexual health outcomes. On completion of the FRESH course, you will:

- have an increased level of confidence working with Aboriginal communities in the area of sexual health
- be able to identify the sexual health issues faced by Aboriginal people in South Australia
- be introduced to new sexual health language and communication skills
- to improve client/worker relationships and more.
